

Young Authors' Support to attend IFAC Symposium LSS 2010

The French IFAC National Member Organization, following the spirit of the IFAC Foundation Program for Support Young Authors Attendance to Major Conferences in the field, has provided funds to support attendees to the IFAC Symposium LSS 2010, under its financial responsibility.

For that purpose, the following agreement has been reached:

The IFAC French NMO will allocate 1500€ in the Symposium budget to grant eligible young authors to attend this meeting. Eligible for support are authors of accepted technical papers – French or citizens of a developing country – whose age will be less than 30 years during the symposium. Only one author per paper can be supported.

A developing country is understood to be one which not on the attached list of high income countries.

The support consists of a lump sum to help defray the cost of registration, accommodation and travel expenses related to the conference.

The conference organizer shall properly publicize this agreement.

Applications should be addressed to the conference organizer by eligible authors.

The selection Committee will be composed of three members: one representing the French IFAC NMO, one representing the Symposium NOC and one nominated by the IFAC Foundation.

Based on quality, needs and geographical criteria, the NOC Chair will propose a prioritized list of selected applicants to the Selection Committee. The list should include the name, the date of birth, the country of citizenship, the current position, the title of the paper to be presented and its evaluation, as well as the registration fee to be applied.

The Selection Committee will communicate the decision to the conference organizer within one month. The conference organizer will contact the winners to make registration, accommodation and travel arrangements as appropriate.

A presentation of the paper at the conference by the winner is a requisite for support.
